Originally a photography school using one location, Brooks now has six separate facilities, four in Santa Barbara and two in Ventura. The programs in Ventura focus on film, photojournalism and graphic design while the Santa Barbara campuses focus on photography and general education. Their degree program is broken into six eightweek long classes, so a bachelor's degree can be earned in about three years. The college has about 1,400 students and over 10,000 graduates working full-time around the world. Dr. Anderson was particularly proud of two students whose film scripts were recently acquired by Steven Spielberg for significant sums.

As their students look for opportunities to photograph subjects and scenes in Ventura, the local Marriott has partnered with Brooks by placing students' photos in every room and the lobby of the hotel. This change has been favorably received, and other Marriotts are considering highlighting their local community in a similar way.

A student may finish the coursework, but that doesn't automatically qualify for receiving a degree until a comprehensive quality review is completed of that student's work and approved by faculty. There is a practical aspect to the training as well; students create their own promotional literature and learn the in's and out's of the business of visual arts.

Brooks is very proud of their award-winning faculty as well as the many students who have gone on in their careers to be leaders in the industry. We are pleased to have Brooks Institute part of our City of Ventura!

Kenyan peace fellow aspires to protect human security

Joseph Hongo of Kenya has long envisioned "a new world order shaped not by military and political might but tolerance and mutual understanding, where issues of human security and development take center stage."

He says his Rotary World Peace Fellowship to study at the University of Queensland in Australia, beginning in February 2009, echoes that ideal. Moreover, he believes the fellowship, sponsored by the Rotary Club of Mombasa, Kenya, and District 9200 in East Africa, will help him achieve his career goal: "to play a lead role in bridging the policy gap between

community and government, policymakers, and other actors in the promotion of human security and economic development."

Hongo's "modest background," as he calls it, has driven him to work hard. Though he is the ninth of 10 children, seven of his siblings died before he was born, and he suffered the loss of his father, a fisherman, and his mother at an early age.

"I regarded myself a child of the community," he says, referring to his upbringing by different relatives. "[They] provided me with the opportunity to live in various parts of the country," instilling an appreciation of other languages and cultures.

In 2002, Hongo graduated with honors from Kenyatta University. The next year, as an intern with Kenya's National Assembly, he traveled to remote parts of the country, meeting with citizens and assessing the implementation of the nation's free primary education policy. He also helped analyze conflicts in rural communities and develop appropriate policies and mitigation measures.

As a program assistant with the Great Lakes Parliamentary Forum on Peace since 2004, Hongo has participated in several peace-building initiatives, he says, including interethnic conflict in Rwanda and Burundi, resource-based conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo, the small-arms problem in northern Kenya and southern Sudan, and displacement and refugee problems


I can't thank you enough for giving me the opportunity to experience RYLA.


