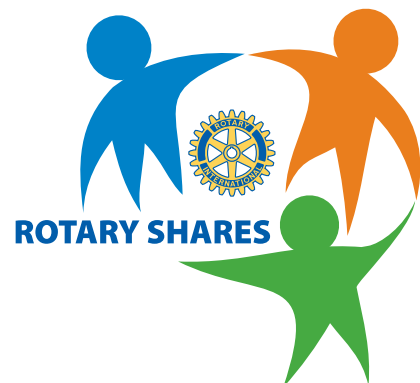

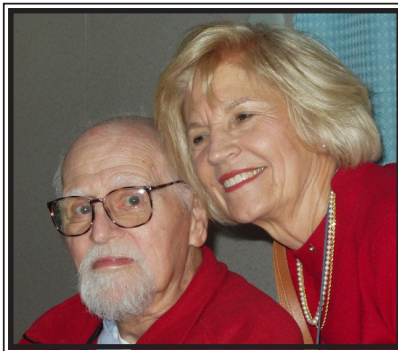
The wine dance was performed for us.


