To finish out the last program of 2010 to the combined Ventura and Ventura-East Rotary Clubs, Jim McConica, told of the

world record-breaking Ventura Deep Six ocean swim team. He was team leader of the 202 mile, 4 ½ day open water relay. The course took them from Ventura to Santa Barbara and then to La Jolla Cove near San Diego. Jim personally holds a number of world swimming records.

The Hotel

The main vessel was 125' long and included 27 rooms and private baths, a hot tub, washer and dryer and other amenities. In addition to the six swimmers, some family accompanied them plus a 9-person film crew, 4 official observers, a reporter from the Star and a few others.

In the water

Although they followed the coastline, their course was as much as 25 miles off of land. The swimmers were guided in the water with their Zodiac boat which had guidance equipment on it. Especially at night and in fog, the swimmers would have no idea which way to swim. The water temperature was particularly cold for two days, getting down to 54° at one point. No wet suits are allowed for this competition. Shark protection was available with a "shark shield" which acts like a Taser to the sharks. They had a problem with jellyfish. Jim described the pain and mark left on his face. Finally, Jim experienced flesh-eating fish at night! He kicked one off of him that may have been 6-8" long.

Challenges

Their relay rotation was to swim one hour every six hours. Jim's schedule was 6 a.m., noon, 6 p.m. and midnight. The number problem was getting enough

sleep. At the most, Jim had 3 hours of sleep. But after getting out of the cold water, the swimmer had to warm their body, then eat, and then sleep. When the swim was over, all they wanted to do is sleep. They had a dispute with the boat's captain. All we know is they completed the journey on the same boat.

Before the swim

They had agreed as a team to have no negative discussions between them. No complaining. The result was they built a very strong team, both physically and mentally.

After the swim

They have had magazine articles, interviews and more. Swimmer magazine's interviewer asked the question, What secrets did you not tell your teammates before than you can tell now? One of the teammates had received an email the day before they began the relay – his best friend's cancer had returned and it didn't look good.

Jim was amazed when he found over 1,000 people were following his Facebook page. His favorite post was from his daughter which contained a picture of his granddaughter Abby sleeping. The caption: I was up all night cheering for you and now I have to sleep.

Team members were from 40-60 years of age:

- Mike Shaffer, 45. Fastest on the team. A tri-athlete.
- Jim Neitz had made great improvements in swimming.
- John Chung, 40. The stallion.
- Tom Ball, 51, owns a Karate studio
- Kurt Baron, 46, and
- Jim McConica, 60.

Jim's messages for us

- 1. We earn the right to perform well. We do this every single day, in everything we do.
- 2. Get your mind right. This axiom ties into the goal of getting rid of negative thoughts. Your body will follow your mind. This is especially true in sports.

Before taking questions, Jim gave us a quote from Aristotle that was printed on his business cards: "We are what we repeatedly do. Excellence, therefore, is not an act but a habit."

Our Rotary Clubs thanked Jim with both applause and a standing ovation.


