and Facebook. They can also add personal messages of support, view ads from around the world, and see which regions are digitally leading the charge to raise awareness of polio eradication.

Rotary's "This Close" ads were introduced at the 2010 International Assembly. Print ads have since run in several publications, including USA Today , the Chicago Tribune , and the Wall Street Journal Asia . Rotarians who attended the 2010 RI Convention also saw them at Montréal-Trudeau International Airport.

The ads feature a growing roster of public figures, including Bill Gates, cochair of the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation; Archbishop Emeritus Desmond Tutu, a Nobel Peace Prize laureate; action movie star Jackie Chan; golf legend Jack Nicklaus; and conservationist Jane Goodall.

Rotary's US\$200 Million Challenge, the ongoing effort to match \$355 million in challenge grants for polio eradication from the Gates Foundation. Here are some tips:

- 1. Create a personalized ad at ThisClose.net and share it on Facebook.
